International Student Fees - 2021

Tuition:	25 hours per week of full time study. Inclusive of five hours per week of ESOL (English to speakers of other languages) <i>if required</i> . (\$350 p/w). Includes textbooks and other required course materials.
Administration:	This includes enrolment, administrative costs and government levy (\$250 per term).
Homestay:	Full board, three meals per day (\$250 p/w).
Placement:	Flat charge. Includes airport pick up and drop off (\$350).

All of the fees are GST inclusive and in New Zealand Dollars

Additional costs may include:

- Insurance: **All students must have evidence of insurance prior to enrolment.** Students can arrange their own or have their agency arrange it for them. Students can also purchase insurance through Western Heights High School.
 - Western Heights High School uses *Uni-care Educational Travel Insurance Service*. The cost is approximately \$500 annually. See: www.uni-care.org for more information.
 - Western Heights High School reserves the right to purchase the student insurance through Uni-care if we feel that their existing policy is inadequate. The student will meet the cost of this.
- International student entry into NCEA standards: \$383.30 per year. Applicable to students who wish to gain NCEA and University Entrance Qualifications.
- School Uniform
 - Approximately \$400 for full school uniform. This can be purchased on site from the 'SAS Sports and Uniform shop'. *For students staying longer than one term.*
 - Students can rent second-hand uniform from the international department for \$100 for the duration of their stay (This does not include socks or shoes). *This is for students staying one term or less.*
- School extra-curricular expenses, school trips and camps (This does not include international student trips).
- Christmas Holiday Fee of \$500. This is to cover administrative and homestay expenses during the Christmas holiday period.
- Extra holiday activities and travelling expenses with school approved commercial operator (such as NZET www.nzet.com) or home stay family.
