## Additional costs may include:

- Insurance: All students must have evidence of insurance prior to enrolment. Students can arrange their own or have their agency arrange it for them. Students can also purchase insurance through Western Heights High School.
- Western Heights High School uses *Uni-care Educational Travel Insurance Service*. The cost is approximately \$600 annually. See: <u>www.uni-care.org</u> for more information.
- Western Heights High School reserves the right to purchase the student insurance through Uni-care if we feel that their existing policy is inadequate. The student will meet the cost of this.
- International student entry into NCEA standards: \$383.30 per year. Applicable to students who wish to gain NCEA and University Entrance Qualifications.
- Student-Visa Renewal Fee (Immigration NZ): \$500 per application.

- School Uniform
- Approximately \$500 for the full school uniform. This can be purchased on site from the 'SAS Sports and Uniform shop at Western Heights High School. For students studying one term or less, uniform rental is \$200.
- School and extracurricular expenses, school trips and camps, including the annual summer programme (\$400 flat fee is required for the summer programme).
- Christmas Holiday Fee of \$500. This is to cover additional homestay expenses during the Christmas holiday period.
- Extra holiday activities and travelling expenses with school approved commercial operators (such as NZET <u>www.nzet.com</u>) or homestay family.
